Initiative to publish an e-News letter have some specific objectives from our end:

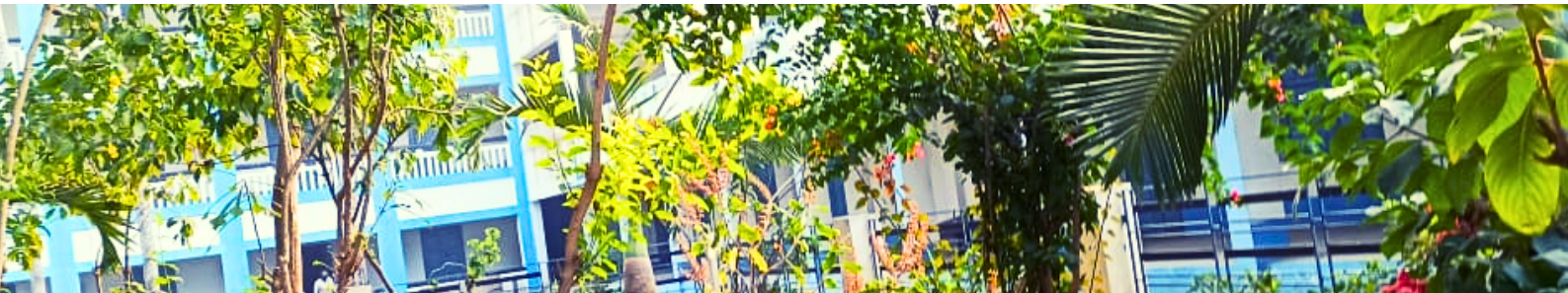
1. During the time of lockdown sharing physical informations was not possible.

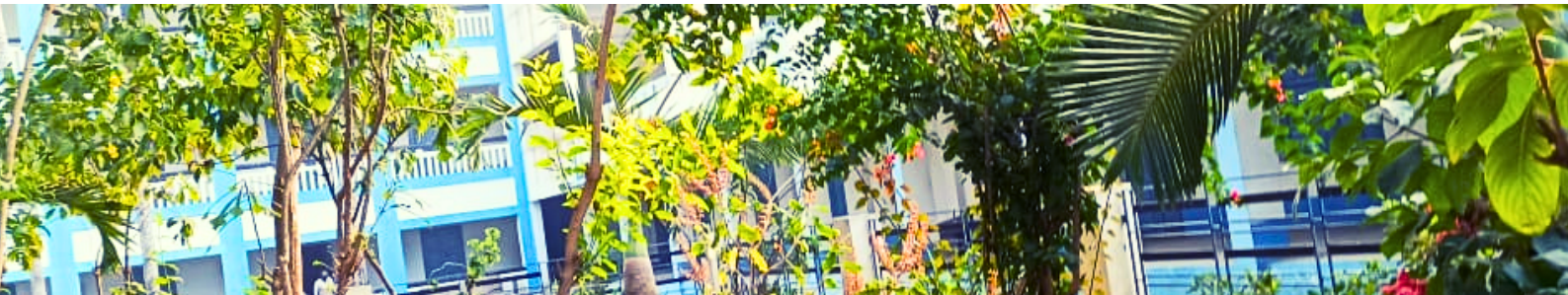

Vision:

Energy is at the heart of most critical economic, environmental and developmental issues facing the world today. It is one of the basic components for smooth functioning of human activity and played a pivotal role in human civilization. Fossil fuels are the conventional sources of energy which are non-renewable and their known reserves are depleting day by day. Therefore, a fresh and systematic power infrastructure investment is needed to meet the current and future energy demand. On the verge of such a global energy crisis due to the rapid dissolution of fossil fuels, self-sustainable integrated energy systems can be the most plausible solution. Finding environmentally benign fossil fuel replica with a broad performance spectrum is still a very encouraging field of research. The increasing craze for portable electronics and hybrid vehicles are raising the bar for the model energy storage systems with high specific energy and power. Organic Solar Cell (OSC) is also a promising alternative for clean and renewable energy due to their potential to be fabricated onto large area, light-weight flexible substrates by solution processing at low cost. In recent times, a tremendous effort related to renewable energy devices has been put forward.
