

— Brief History of the College

Karimpur is located at the border between Nadia and Murshidabad and is also very near to our neighbouring country, Bangladesh. So the place has its own socio-political and cultural importance from the very beginning. On 4th August 1968 as a 'Home of Higher Education' Karimpur Pannadevi College was established to cater higher education to the people of Karimpur and its vast locality, particularly for the students belonging to the poor and middle-class families who cannot afford to go far off places for meeting the demand of higher education. The establishment of the College was possible with the indomitable zeal of Dr. Nalinaksha Sanyal, an illustrious son of the soil and the donation made by Sri Durga Prasad Agarwala, and the College was named after his wife Pannadevi Agarwala. Patrons of education from all spheres of society supported wholeheartedly towards the foundation of the College, either by contributing cash or by donating land. The College initially started functioning in Karimpur Jagannath High School in the morning shift and later shifted to its own buildings in January 1970.

The College now has a three-storied building measuring about 40,000 sq.ft., with a campus of about 7 acres. Presently the College offers education to around 4,000 students in Arts and Science streams. Students come from different corners of the locality. The college has its well-furnished spacious Guest House and separate Science Extension and Research Block. The college is accredited by NAAC with B+ Grade and has M.O.U. with Krishnagar Women's College, Ramakrishna Mission Sikshanamandira, Ramakrishna Mission Vivekananda Centenary College, Ramakrishna Mission Swami Vivekananda's Ancestral House and Cultural Centre, Jalangi Mahavidyalaya, Netaji Subhas Open University and Resonanz Career Centre.


Overview

ANTI RAGGING CELL

As per the Govt. Rule the Karimpur Pannadevi College has an Anti-Ragging Cell to monitor the unwanted incidents of ragging in the campus of our institution. The Cell takes strong action against ragging as per the Anti-ragging Act, 2000 of Government of West Bengal and the Supreme Court's order of May 2007, the judgement of the Supreme Court on Ragging (2009) and the UGC Resolution to curb the menace of Ragging (2009). It will lodge F.I.R. and rusticate the students involved in any form of ragging. Punishments of ragging include jail for 2 years or penalty of Rs. 5000 or both.

GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL CELL

Functions:

- 1. The Cell deals with the grievances of the students, members of the teaching and non-teaching staff
- 2.At the beginning of an academic session the cell inform the students about its activities. To receive grievances, it has installed a Complaints' Box in which any one can drop complaints against persons, service and also on infrastructure of the college.
- 3. After receiving a complaint, it proceeds to redress the grievances with varying approach depending upon the nature of the complaints:
- 4. In the event of minor grievances against person(s) it discusses with the converned parties and offers plausible solutions. In the event of grave personal offences, it may forward to other authorities like Teachers Council or Non-Teachers' Council or even to the GB. Misbehavior of any person is dealt with discussing with concerned persons in presence of the Disciplinary Action Committee.
- 5. Complaints related to services are dealt in meetings with the concerned advisory bodies/sub-committees.
- 6.Inadequacy of any infrastructure/facility (like non supplying of drinking water is discussed with the Development Sub-Committee
- 7. Complaints related to teaching and learning are discussed with the Academic Council.
